No revision in BOQ prices shall be admissible on account of any other change in PF/ESIC/Bonus rates or other statutory provisions whatsoever. The bidders shall account for all these statutory provisions while quoting the price. (ii) On completion of one year execution of work, accepted BOQ rates for chemicals and machines i.e. BOQ subclauses (1.02, 2.02, 3.02, 4.02, 5.02, 6.02, 7.02, 8.02, 9.02, 10.02, 11.02, 12.02) and sub-clauses (1.03, 2.03, 3.03, 4.03, 5.03, 6.03, 7.03, 8.03, 9.03, 10.03, 11.03, 12.03) shall be increased by 5%. If the contract period is extended beyond 2 years, the rates of second year shall be applicable for the extended period."
