- 1. The Bidder shall attach copy of LOAs / POs/Work Orders along with their work completion certificates or performance certificate (for running contracts) issued by the authorized signatory preferably on their letter head. For bidders submitting LOA/P.O. of JMRC for work Experience need not to submit Work completion certificates. JMRC will examine the factual details of Work awarded and satisfactory completion of work by firm at time of Bid evaluation.
- 2. For contracts which are running or under progress, the bidder shall submit performance report (satisfactory) of the running work. Comprising of at least following information: a. Name of work, b. Name of firm, c. Date of commencement of work in actual d. performance during e. Contract No./LOA number.
- The completion certificate shall at least be comprised of following information: a. Name of work, b. Name of firm, c. Date of Actual completion, d. Total value (Amount) of work done, e. Performance during execution, f. Name of agreement/LOA number.
- d) Firm should not have been be blacklisted by Central Government, any State Government or any Government agency or Public sector undertaking (PSU). Firm shall submit an undertaking to this effect as per Form-I: Black list /Termination Undertaking.
- e) POWER OF ATTORNEY (Form: H): In case bidder's firm is Partnership/ Company/ Consortium then, a power of attorney to be submitted. The power of attorney is to be signed by the partners or legally authorized signatories of all the partners authorizing the nominated person to be In-charge to sign bid document, incur all liabilities and receive instructions.

2.0 INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS

2.1 Sale of Bidding/ Bid Documents

- 2.1.1.1 The sale of bidding documents shall be commenced from the date of publication of Notice Inviting Bids (NIB). The complete bidding documents shall also be placed on the State Public Procurement Portal and JMRC website as per NIB. The prospective Bidders shall download the bidding document from the specified website(s) and pay its bid cost on or before while submitting the bid to the procuring entity.
- 2.1.1.2 The bidding documents shall be made available to any prospective Bidders who pays the Bid cost for it in cash or by bank demand draft, banker's cheque Bid documents cost is not refundable.

2.2 Cost of bid document and Bid Security/EMD

- 2.2.1.1 The BID should be submitted in the prescribed Bid document, which may be purchased for Rs. 590/- including 18% GST, by Cash or DD/Banker Cheque drawn in favour of "Jaipur Metro Rail Corporation Ltd.", payable at Jaipur. The complete bid document can also be downloaded from the website http://transport.rajasthan.gov.in/jmrc or www.sppp.rajasthan.gov.in. In case the bid document is down loaded from website, the cost of bid document is to be submitted in the form of DD/Banker's Cheque along with the Bid document submitted.
- 2.2.1.2 In lieu of bid security amount, a Bid Security Declaration in prescribed format has to be submitted on Non-Judicial stamp Paper of Rs 50/- (as per Form: K) along with Cost of Bid. The bidder required to pay the bid security amount as specified in Para 6 of NIB, in case of shortfall mentioned in Form K, point (a) to (e).
- 2.2.1.3 The Bid Security Liable to be paid as per T&C of bid in the following cases, namely: -
 - a) When the bidder withdraws or modifies its bid after opening of bids;
 - When bidder do not execute the agreement, if any, after placement of supply/work order within specified period;
 - When the Bidder fails to commence the supply of the goods or service or execute work as per supply/ work order within the time specified;
 - When the Bidder does not deposit the performance security within specified period after the supply/ work order is placed; and



- e) If the Bidder breaches any provision of code of integrity prescribed for bidding specified in the bidding document.
- 2.2.1.4 In case of non-submission of Bid Security Declaration on Non- Judicial stamp Paper of Rs 50/- (as per FORM: K), the bid will be summarily rejected.

2.3 Changes in the Bidding Document

- 2.3.1.1 At any time, prior to the deadline for submission of Bids, the procuring entity may for any reason, whether on its own initiative or as a result of a request for clarification by a Bidder, modify the bidding documents by issuing an addendum in accordance with the provisions below.
- 2.3.1.2 In case, any modification is made to the bidding document or any clarification is issued which materially affects the terms contained in the bidding document, the procuring entity shall publish such modification or clarification in the same manner as the publication of the initial bidding document.
- 2.3.1.3 In case, a clarification or modification is issued to the bidding document, the procuring entity may, prior to the last date for submission of Bids, extend such time limit in order to allow the bidders sufficient time to take into account the clarification or modification, as the case may be, while submitting their Bids.

2.4 Period of Validity of Bids

- 2.4.1.1 Bids submitted by the Bidders shall remain valid during the period specified in the NIB/ bidding document. A Bid valid for a shorter period may be rejected by the procuring entity as non-responsive Bid.
- 2.4.1.2 Prior to the expiry of the period of validity of Bids, the procuring entity, in exceptional circumstances, may request the Bidders to extend the bid validity period for an additional specified period of time. A Bidder may refuse the request and such refusal shall be treated as withdrawal of Bid and in such circumstances Bid Security shall not be forfeited, if applicable.

2.5 Format and Signing of Bids

- 2.5.1.1 The Bidder shall prepare one original set of the bidding documents called Bid in the manner as specified in the bidding document.
- 2.5.1.2 All pages the bid shall be signed by the Bidder or a person duly authorized to sign on behalf of the Bidder, in token of acceptance of all the terms and conditions of the bidding documents. This authorization shall consist of a written confirmation as per "Certificate of Conformity/ No-Deviation" of the bidding document and shall be attached to the technical bid.
- 2.5.1.3 Any corrections in the bid such as interlineations, erasures, or overwriting shall be valid only if they are signed or initialed by the person signing the bid.



2.6 Sealing and Marking of Bids

- 2.6.1.1 The bids shall be submitted as described below.
- 2.6.1.2 The bids shall be submitted in Two Sealed Envelopes (Envelope 1 and Envelope 2) marked as Cover: 1st and Cover: 2nd respectively. Both the cover should be separated and they should be enclosed in another common Envelope (3rd cover). Name of work, Name of bidder and last date of receipt of bids should be mention on each Envelope.
- 2.6.1.3 The Envelope 1 shall contain the following:
 - A. <u>Bid Cost and Bid Security:</u> Bid cost and Bid security shall be enclosed as Para 2.2 of Bid Document.
 - B. <u>Power of Attorney:</u> In accordance with relevant clause and authorization for executing the power of attorney as per clause 16(e) of NIB. (Form H) (If applicable).
 - Corrigendum: Any Corrigendum / Amendment issued up to last date / time of submission of NIT & Uploaded / Posted on website.
 - D. Check list as per clause 8.0.
- 2.6.1.4 In case, Envelope 1 is not annexed or bid cost, EMD etc. not found in proper form, the Envelope 2 containing bid documents will not be opened at all.
- 2.6.1.5 The Envelope 2 (Cover: 2nd) marked as "SECOND COVER FOR THE WORK OF (NAME OF WORK)" should contain: Eligibility criteria, bid documents containing terms and conditions, specifications, schedule of quantities etc. complete as original bid documents got issued from JMRC or downloaded from the internet. The rates and amounts should be filled only in the BOQ (schedule of quantities) attached thereto. The bidder shall enclose duly signed and stamped, copy of the Bid Document, documents supporting eligibility criteria and the Financial Bid (BOQ).
- 2.6.1.6 Bids, signed without any of the information desired in the prescribed formats will not be considered. Besides this all other associated / required documents shall be submitted duly numbered and signed/ stamped by the bidders.

2.7 Cost & Language of Bidding

- 2.7.1.1 The Bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its Bid, and the procuring entity shall not be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.
- 2.7.1.2 The Bid, as well as all correspondence and documents relating to the Bid exchanged by the bidders and the procuring entity, shall be written only in English/ Hindi Language. Supporting documents and printed literature that are part of the Bid may be in another language provided they are accompanied by an accurate translation of the relevant passages in English/ Hindi language, in which case, for purposes of interpretation of the Bid, such translation shall govern.

2.8 Alternative/ Multiple Bids

2.8.1.1 Alternative/ Multiple Bids shall not be considered at all.

2.9 Deadline for the submission of Bids

2.9.1.1 Bids shall be received, by the person, designated for the purpose, by the procuring entity or directly dropped in the bid box, at the place and up to the time and date specified in the NIB.

2.10 Late Bids

- 2.10.1.1 The person authorized to receive the bids shall not receive any bid that is submitted personally, after the time and date fixed for submission of bids.
- 2.10.1.2 Any bid, which arrives by post after he deadline for submission of bids, shall be declared and marked as "Late" and returned unopened to the Bidder.

2.11 Receipt and Custody of Bids

- 2.11.1.1 The bids shall be received by hand delivery, by courier or by post in the specified format up to the specified time and date and at the specified place, by the person authorized by the procuring entity.
- 2.11.1.2 All bids received unsealed, in torn or damaged condition through post or by personal delivery shall be so marked and signed on the cover by the person receiving the same and get signed on it by the person delivering it and put in a fresh cover and reseal, if so warranted. All such entries shall be attested by the receiving person.
- 2.11.1.3 The received bids shall be kept in safe custody in lock and key by the person authorized to receive the bids.
- 2.11.1.4 The location of bid box shall be such as to facilitate easy access to Bidders.
- 2.11.1.5 Bids received by the authorized person on or before the time and date fixed for receipt of bids shall be entered in bids receipt register and the same shall be closed at the scheduled time and date giving in words and figures the number of bids received up to the last time and date for submission of bids.
- 2.11.1.6 The record of bids received late through post shall be entered in bids receipt register after closing the register as per above.
- 2.11.1.7 Bids received by telegram or given on form other than the prescribed form shall not be considered.

2.12 Withdrawal, Substitution, and Modification of Bids

- 2.12.1.1 A Bidder may withdraw, substitute, or modify its bid after it has been submitted by sending a written Notice, duly signed by an authorized signatory, and shall include a copy of the authorization. The corresponding substitution or modification of the bid must accompany the respective written Notice. All Notices must be: -
 - Submitted in accordance with the bidding document, and in addition, the respective envelopes shall be clearly marked "Withdrawal," "Substitution," "Modification"; and
 - Received by the procuring entity prior to the deadline prescribed for submission of bids.

- 2.12.1.2 Bids requested to be withdrawn shall be returned unopened to the Bidders.
- 2.12.1.3 No bid shall be withdrawn, substituted, or modified in the interval between the deadline for submission of bids and the expiration of the period of the specified bid validity or any extension thereof.

2.13 Opening of Bids

- 2.13.1.1 The sealed bid box shall be opened by the bid opening committee constituted by the procuring entity at the time, date and place specified in the bidding document in the presence of the Bidders or their authorized representatives, who choose to be present.
- 2.13.1.2 The bids receiving person shall also hand over all the bids received by him up to the time and date for submission of bids to the Convener of bids opening committee and obtain its signature in the bids receipt register.
- 2.13.1.3 The bid opening committee may co-opt experienced persons in the committee to conduct the process of bid opening.
- 2.13.1.4 The bids shall be opened by the bids opening committee in the presence of the Bidders or their authorized representatives who choose to be present. All envelopes containing bids shall be signed with date by the members of the committee in token of verification of the fact that they are sealed. The envelopes shall be numbered as a/n, where 'a' denotes the serial number at which the bid envelop has been taken for opening and 'n' denotes the total number of bids received by specified time.
- 2.13.1.5 The bid opening committee shall prepare a list of the Bidders or their representatives attending the opening of bids and obtain their signatures on the same. The list shall also contain the representative's name and telephone number and corresponding Bidders' names and addresses. The authority letters brought by the representatives shall be attached to the list. The list shall be signed by all the members of bid opening committee with date and time of opening of the bids.
- 2.13.1.6 Bids should always be placed in sealed envelope, in the manner detailed in Para 2.6 will be received and opened on the due dates by committee.
- 2.13.1.7 Envelope 1 (Cover 1st) enclosing the Bid Security, Bid cost etc. [As per clause 2.6.1.3] shall be opened on the scheduled date and time.
- 2.13.1.8 In case Envelope 1 is not annexed with bid cost, EMD, etc. or not found in acceptable form, the Envelope 2 containing eligibility criteria, bid documents will not be opened at all and such unopened bids shall be returned on spot to the bidder or his representative during the process of opening of bids/ or by through post, as the case may be. The bid cost deposited for issue of bid documents/Demand Draft along with downloaded bid shall not be refunded, if bidder is found ineligible.



- 2.13.1.9 Envelope 2 (Cover: 2nd) containing eligibility criteria and bid documents complete as original shall be opened on the scheduled date and time of bid opening if found eligible as per Envelope 1.
- 2.13.1.10 After the opening of Envelope 2 of eligible bidders, the bid documents containing terms & conditions, specifications and Bill of quantities (BoQ) etc. shall be evaluated by JMRC.
- 2.13.1.11 If it is found at any stage of bid evaluation after submission of bid that the bidder has made any correction/addition/alternation/omission in bid documents vis-a-vis bid documents available on the website/original draft NIB in office, the bid shall be treated as non-responsive and shall be summarily rejected and the EMD deposited by bidder shall be forfeited in addition to any other action as per prevalent rules.
- 2.13.1.12 Envelopes shall be opened one at a time and the following details shall be read out and recorded:
 - a. the name of the Bidder and whether there is a substitution or modification;
 - the bid prices (per lot if applicable);
 - c. the Bid Declaration Form
 - d. Any other details as the committee may consider appropriate.
- 2.13.1.13 After all the bids have been opened, they shall be initialed and dated on the first page of the each bid by the members of the bids opening committee. All the pages of the price schedule and letters, Bill of Quantities attached shall be initialed and dated by the members of the committee. Key information such as prices, delivery period, etc. shall be encircled and unfilled spaces in the bids shall be marked and signed with date by the members of the committee. The original and additional copies of the bid shall be marked accordingly. Alterations/ corrections/ additions/ over-writings shall be initialed legibly to make it clear that such alteration, etc., were existing in the bid at the time of opening.
- 2.13.1.14 No bid shall be rejected at the time of bid opening except the late bids, alternative bids (if not permitted) and bids not accompanied with the proof of payment or instrument of the required price of bidding document, processing fee (if any) or user charges and Bid Security Declaration on Non-Judicial stamp Paper of Rs 50/- (as per FORM: K).

2.14 Selection Method

- 2.14.1.1 The selection method is Least Cost Based Selection (LCBS) i.e. Least bid price as detailed below:
 - Bid will be opened on scheduled time and date as per NIB. A.
 - The contract shall be awarded to most advantageous technically responsive bidder R quoting least value of Total Cost incl. Taxes in financial bid BoQ (L1) subject to the fulfillment of Eligibility criteria mentioned in clause 16 of NIB.
 - The ranking of L1, L2, L3 etc, will be done on basis of Total Cost, with L1 being the C. bidder whose Total Cost is the lowest, L2 being the second lowest and so on.
 - Bidder shall quote price for each items and sub-items. D.



The purchase Order/work order shall be given to only One Bidder.

2.15 Clarification of Bids

- 2.15.1.1 To assist in the examination, evaluation, comparison and qualification of the Bids, the bid evaluation committee may, at its discretion, ask any Bidder for a clarification regarding its Bid. The committee's request for clarification and the response of the Bidder shall be in writing.
- 2.15.1.2 Any clarification submitted by a Bidder with regard to its Bid that is not in response to a request by the committee shall not be considered.
- 2.15.1.3 No change in the prices or substance of the Bid shall be sought, offered, or permitted, except to confirm the correction of arithmetic errors discovered by the committee in the evaluation of the financial Bids.
- 2.15.1.4 No substantive change to qualification information or to a submission, including changes aimed at making an unqualified Bidder, qualified or an unresponsive submission, responsive shall be sought, offered or permitted.
- 2.15.1.5 All communications generated under this rule shall be included in the record of the procurement proceedings.

2.16 Evaluation & Tabulation of Bids

2.16.1.1 Preliminary Examination of Bids

- The bid evaluation committee constituted by the procuring entity shall conduct a preliminary A. scrutiny of the opened bids to assess the prima-facie responsiveness.
- In case Envelope 1 is not annexed with bid cost, EMD, etc. or not found in acceptable form, the B. Envelope 2 containing eligibility criteria, bid documents will not be opened at all and such unopened bids shall be returned on spot to the bidder or his representative during the process of opening of bids/ or by through post, as the case may be. The bid cost deposited for issue of bid documents/Demand Draft along with downloaded bid shall not be refunded, if bidder is found ineligible.
- Envelope 2 (Cover: 2nd) containing eligibility criteria and bid documents complete as original C. shall be opened on the scheduled date and time of bid opening if found eligible as per Envelope 1.
- After the opening of Envelope 2 of eligible bidders, the bid documents containing terms & D. conditions, specifications and Bill of quantities (BoQ) etc. shall be evaluated by JMRC.

Determination of Responsiveness 2.16.1.2

The bid evaluation committee shall determine the responsiveness of a Bid on the basis of A. bidding document and the provisions of pre-qualification/ eligibility criteria of the bidding document.



- A responsive Bid is one that meets the requirements of the bidding document without any B. material deviation, reservation, or omission where: -
 - "deviation" is a departure from the requirements specified in the bidding document;
 - "reservation" is the setting of limiting conditions or withholding from ii. complete acceptance of the requirements specified in the bidding document; and
 - "Omission" is the failure to submit part or all of the information or iii. documentation required in the bidding document.
 - C. A material deviation, reservation, or omission is one that,
 - if accepted, shall:-
 - affect in any substantial way the scope, quality, or performance of the subject 1. matter of procurement specified in the bidding documents; or
 - limits in any substantial way, inconsistent with the bidding documents, the 2. procuring entity's rights or the Bidder's obligations under the proposed contract; or
 - ii. If rectified, shall unfairly affect the competitive position of other Bidders presenting responsive Bids.
 - D. The bid evaluation committee shall examine the technical aspects of the Bid in particular, to confirm that all requirements of bidding document have been met without any material deviation, reservation or omission.
 - The procuring entity shall regard a Bid as responsive if it conforms to all requirements set out in the bidding document, or it contains minor deviations that do not materially alter or depart from the characteristics, terms, conditions and other requirements set out in the bidding document, or if it contains errors or oversights that can be corrected without touching on the substance of the Bid.

Non-material Non-conformities in Bids 2.16.1.3

- The bid evaluation committee may waive any non-conformity in the Bid that does not A. constitute a material deviation, reservation or omission, the Bid shall be deemed to be substantially responsive.
- The bid evaluation committee may request the Bidder to submit the necessary B. information or document like GST certificate, Pan Certificate, etc. within a reasonable period of time. Failure of the Bidder to comply with the request may result in the rejection of its Bid.
- The bid evaluation committee may rectify non-material nonconformities or omissions C. on the basis of the information or documentation received from the Bidder under above.



- D. Bids shall be evaluated based on the documents submitted as a part of bid. Bidders are expected to quote for all the items. Similarly, in case the proposal of a Bidder is non-responsive for any item, the Bidder shall be summarily rejected.
- E. The evaluation shall include all costs and all taxes and duties applicable to the Bidder as per law of the Central/ State Government/ Local Authorities, and the evaluation criteria specified in the bidding documents shall only be applied;
- F. The offers shall be evaluated and marked L1, L2, L3 etc. L1 being the lowest offer quoting least value of "Total Cost" in financial bid. A list of L1, L2....will be prepared accordingly.
- G. The rates quoted by L1 Bidder shall be accepted as the bid rates for each item.
- H. The members of bid evaluation committee shall give their recommendations below the table regarding lowest bid or most advantageous bid and sign it.

2.17 Correction of Arithmetic Errors in Financial Bids:

- 2.17.1.1 The bid evaluation committee shall correct arithmetical errors in substantially responsive Bids, on the following basis, namely: -
- 2.17.1.2 If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected, unless in the opinion of the bid evaluation committee there is an obvious misplacement of the decimal point in the unit price, in which case the total price as quoted shall govern and the unit price shall be corrected;
- 2.17.1.3 If there is an error in a total corresponding to the addition or subtraction of subtotals, the subtotals shall prevail and the total shall be corrected; and if there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail, unless the amount expressed in words is related to an arithmetic error, in which case the amount in figures shall prevail subject to clause (2.17.1.2) and above.

2.18 Price/ purchase preference in evaluation:

2.18.1.1 Price and/ or purchase preference notified by the State Government (GoR) and as mentioned in the bidding document shall be considered in the evaluation of Bids and award of contract.

2.19 Negotiations

- 2.19.1.1 Negotiations may, however, be undertaken with the lowest Bidder when the rates of any job type are considered to be much higher than the prevailing market rates or the rates quoted for that job type by other bidders.
- 2.19.1.2 The bid evaluation committee shall have full powers to undertake negotiations. Detailed reasons and results of negotiations shall be recorded in the proceedings.



- The lowest Bidder shall be informed in writing either through messenger or by registered 2.19.1.3 letter and e-mail (if available). A minimum time shall be given for calling negotiations. In case of urgency the bid evaluation committee, after recording reasons, may reduce the time, provided the lowest or most advantageous Bidder has received the intimation and consented to regarding holding of negotiations.
- Negotiations shall not make the original offer made by the Bidder inoperative. The bid 2.19.1.4 evaluation committee shall have option to consider the original offer in case the Bidder decides to increase rates originally quoted or imposes any new terms or conditions.
- In case of non-satisfactory achievement of rates from lowest Bidder, the bid evaluation 2.19.1.5 committee may choose to make a written counter offer to the lowest Bidder and if this is not accepted by him, the committee may decide to reject and re-invite Bids or to make the same counter-offer first to the second lowest or most advantageous Bidder, then to the third lowest or most advantageous Bidder and so on in the order of their initial standing and work/ supply order be awarded to the Bidder who accepts the counter-offer. This procedure would be used in exceptional cases only.
- 2.19.1.6 In case the rates even after the negotiations are considered very high, Tender may be annulled and fresh Bids invited.

2.20 Acceptance of the successful Bid and Issuance of Purchase Order

- 2.20.1.1 The procuring entity after considering the recommendations of the bid evaluation committee and the conditions of Bid, if any, financial implications, trials, sample testing and test reports, etc., shall accept or reject the successful Bid. If any member of the bid evaluation committee has disagreed or given its note of dissent, the matter shall be referred to the next higher authority, as per delegation of financial powers, for decision.
- 2.20.1.2 Decision on Bids shall be taken within original validity period of Bids and time period allowed to procuring entity for taking decision. If the decision is not taken within the original validity period OR time limit allowed for taking decision, the matter shall be referred to the next higher authority in delegation of financial powers for decision.
- 2.20.1.3 Before issuance of purchase order the procuring entity shall ensure that the price of successful Bid is reasonable and consistent with the required quality.
- 2.20.1.4 A Bid shall be treated as successful only after the competent authority has approved the procurement in terms of that Bid.
- 2.20.1.5 The Bid Security of the Bidders who's Bids could not be accepted shall be refunded soon after the contract with the successful Bidder is signed and its performance security is obtained, if applicable.



2.21 Procuring entity's right to accept or reject any or all Bids

2.21.1.1 The Procuring entity reserves the right to accept or reject any Bid, and to annul (cancel) the bidding process and reject all Bids at any time prior to award of contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the Bidders as per RTPP Act and Rules.

2.22 Right to Vary Quantity

- 2.22.1 Right to vary Quantity will be governed as per Rule 73 of RTPPR, 2013 up to latest amended.
- 2.22.2 If the procuring entity does not procure any subject matter of procurement or procures less than the quantity specified in the bidding documents due to change in circumstances, the bidder shall not be entitled for any claim or compensation except otherwise provided in the bidding documents.
- 2.22.3 Repeat orders for extra items or additional quantities may be placed, if it is provided in the bidding documents, on the rates and conditions given in the contract if the original order was given after inviting open competitive bids. Delivery or completion period may also be proportionately increased. The limits of repeat order shall be as under-
 - (a) 50% of the quantity of the individual items and 50% of the value of original contract in case of works; and
 - (b) 50% of the value of goods or services of the original contract.

2.23 Performance Security Deposit

- 2.23.1 Prior to execution of work order, Performance security shall be solicited from all successful Bidder except the departments of the State Government and undertakings, corporations, autonomous bodies, registered societies, co-operative societies which are owned or controlled or managed by the State Government and undertakings of the Central Government. However, a performance security declaration shall be taken from them. The State Government may relax the provision of performance security in particular procurement or any class of procurement.
- 2.23.2 The amount of performance security shall be as per mentioned in NIB in Bid Document. The Performance Security may be deducted from running bill/final bill on request by contractor in writing and approval by competent authority.
- 2.23.3 Performance Security will be discharged after completion of bidder's performance obligations including warranty obligations under the contract.
- 2.23.4 If the bidder fails or neglects any of his obligations under the contract, JMRC reserve the right to forfeit performance security furnished by the bidder as penalty for such failure.
- 2.23.5 Performance security shall be furnished in any one of the following forms: -
 - Bank Draft or Banker's Cheque of a scheduled bank;
 - b. Bank guarantee/s of a scheduled bank. It shall be got verified from the issuing bank. Other conditions regarding bank guarantee shall be same as mentioned in the bidding document for Bid Security, if applicable.



- Fixed Deposit Receipt (FDR) of a scheduled bank. It shall be in the name of procuring C. entity on account of Bidder and discharged by the Bidder in advance. The procuring entity shall ensure before accepting the FDR that the Bidder furnishes an undertaking from the bank to make payment/ premature payment of the FDR on demand to the procuring entity without requirement of consent of the Bidder concerned. In the event of forfeiture of the performance security, the Fixed Deposit shall be forfeited along with interest earned on such Fixed Deposit.
- 2.23.6 Performance security furnished in the form specified in clause 2.23.5 [b.] to [c] above shall remain valid for a period of 26 months from the date of LOA i.e. including all contractual obligations of the Bidder, including warranty obligations and maintenance and defect liability period. In case, the time of completion of work gets enlarged / extended, JMRC has full right to get the validity of performance security extended to cover such enlarges / extended time.
- 2.23.7 Forfeiture of Performance Security: Security amount in full or part may be forfeited, including interest, if any, in the following cases:-
 - When any terms and condition of the contract is breached.
 - b. When the Bidder fails to make complete supply/service satisfactorily.
 - c. If the Bidder breaches any provision of code of integrity, prescribed for Bidders, specified in the bidding document.
- 2.23.8 Notice will be given to the Bidder with reasonable time before Performance Security deposited is forfeited.
- 2.23.9 No interest shall be payable on the Performance Security Deposit.

General Conditions of Contract 3.0

Terms & Conditions 3.1

Contract Documents: 3.1.1

Subject to the order of precedence set forth in the Agreement, all documents forming the 3.1.1.1 Contract (and all parts thereof) are intended to be correlative, complementary, and mutually explanatory.

3.1.2 Scope of Work

- This is a running rate contract which shall be valid for one year from the date of award of 3.1.2.1 work, so JMRC shall give Letter of Indent (LOI) to execute the works as and when required during the currency of contract. The work is to be carried out anywhere in Jaipur city in the jurisdiction of JMRC. The contractor has to execute the given works as per the specifications and running contractor's bills shall be paid by JMRC.
- The contract period for execution of the above mentioned works is one year from the date 3.1.2.2 of award/ LOA of the rate contract. However the time period of contract may be extended



for further Three months on mutual acceptance of contractor and JMRC at same prices, terms and conditions as per rule 29(i), RTPPR, 2013.

- The scope of work includes the refilling, hydraulic pressure testing and replacement of 3.1.2.3 accessories of Fire Extinguishers and Weight monitoring/Gas flooding system of fire installed at different locations of Mansarovar Depot and nine Metro stations of JMRC.
- The bidder will execute this work including all spares, materials, tools & labor etc. as per 3.1.2.4 BOQ. Transportation of cylinders from JMRC site to Bidder's work and return to respective site is in Bidder's scope.
- Any other item that may require for repair/service of Fire Extinguisher or to complete the 3.1.2.5 work specified in bid and proper functioning of the Extinguisher, will be borne by bidder and no extra charges shall be paid for this.
- The Quantity of Fire Extinguishers for refilling and H.P. testing may vary Positive as well as 3.1.2.6 negative side as per Rule 73 of RTPPR, 2013 up to latest amended and the payment as per actual quantity shall be paid as per payment clause.
- During Contract for refilling and hydraulic pressure testing for different types of fire 3.1.2.7 extinguishers following steps to be carried out by the bidder:
 - All the fire extinguishers as per LOI (Letter of Indent) issued to the bidder for refilling A. and Hydraulic pressure testing will be collected by the bidder according to availability by JE/FIRE/JMRC or authorized representative of JMRC E&M department.
 - The bidder or his authorized representative shall lift the each lot of fire extinguishers B. within Five days from the date of intimation/issue of LOI.
 - Fire extinguisher may be refilled/tested on the spot or refilled/tested at the factory C. and brought back to the Depot premises / nine metro stations of JMRC.
 - Refilling and Testing shall be done strictly as per BIS specifications & as per standard D. procedure.
 - Each fire extinguisher must be identified with a suitable sticker having following E. details:

- G. The refilling powder for these Fire Extinguishers shall meet all requirements covered under IS 14609:1999.
- The Refilling of chemicals like CO2 in CO2 gas cylinder, Mechanical Foam type, Water H. and DCP(Dry Chemical Powder) Fire Extinguishers shall meet requirements covered under IS 2878, IS 940 respectively.
- All the Fire Extinguishers to be returned in good condition after refilling/testing as 1. per delivery schedule.
- The cost of refilling/testing of Fire Extinguishers shall include the cost of labor, J. refilling material, transportation of fire extinguishers at Depot premises/all nine metro stations of JMRC.
- All incidental arrangements for safe transport of fire extinguishers shall be the K. responsibility of the bidder. All expenditure to be incurred in this connection shall be borne by bidder.
- The bidder has to submit the test report of refilling material and testing of fire L. extinguishers on firm's letter head, testing certificate is having as per BIS.
- In case of emergency, bidder should be ready to hydraulic test and refill the M. cylinders within the period as required by JMRC.
- The contractor has to submit the test report of refilling material and testing of fire 3.1.2.8 extinguishers on the firm's letterhead, testing certificate is having as per BIS.
- 3.1.2.9 Subject to the provisions in the bidding document and contract, the goods and related services to be supplied shall be as specified in the Letter of Acceptance.

3.1.2.10 Refilling and Hydraulic Pressure Testing of CO2 cylinders

- 3.1.2.10.1 The Hydraulic Pressure testing & refilling of CO2 cylinders shall be carried out through a CCE(PESO) approved agency only as per GAS cylinder Rule & guidelines.
- 3.1.2.10.2 The bidder has to submit the hydraulic pressure test certificate from licensed firm/PESO approved agency /laboratory certifying that hydraulic pressure testing has been done as per relevant IS.
- 3.1.2.10.3 Refilling of all CO2 cylinders should be done as per IS: 2878.
- 3.1.2.10.4 Bidder should have valid license /clearances for possession and refilling of CO2 gas and for carrying out the hydraulic testing of pressurized cylinders as per Gas cylinder rules and submit the certificates for the same to JMRC along with the first bill.
- 3.1.2.10.5 Purity certificate for CO2 shall be submitted by the bidder at the time of submission of bill of respective CO2 cylinders refilled. The purity of CO2 shall be as per IS: 307.
- 3.1.2.10.6 The bidder should check the gross weight of the refilled extinguishers at normal temperature before delivery of the same to JMRC.
- 3.1.2.11 Refilling and Hydraulic pressure testing of Weight monitoring/ Gas flooding System



3.1.2.11.1 Dismantling of weight monitoring system from JMRC site, Refilling, Hydraulic pressure testing, installation with accessories, proper fitting and functioning of WMS is in scope of bidder.

3.1.3 General Care

- 3.1.3.1 All the parts shall be checked before refilling, which are found to be defective and require replacement. All the defective accessories replaced should be sent back to site.
- 3.1.3.2 After refilling of cylinders, especially valve and fittings shall be suitably packed to avoid leakage during transportation.
- 3.1.3.3 Bidder shall handle the material with due care & if damaged during transportation or at the time of performing job due to shear negligence, then the cost of repairing or replacement of the parts shall be borne by bidder.
- 3.1.3.4 JMRC representative may be deputed at Bidder's work shop to witness the hydraulic testing/servicing/refilling of the fire extinguishers.
- 3.1.3.5 The work should be carried without causing any hindrance to the users.
- 3.1.3.6 Only authorized staff of contractor having proper identity card issued by the contractor/firm shall be permitted to enter in JMRC premises.

3.1.4 Delivery/ (completion of work)

- 3.1.4.1 If national holiday is being declared on bid due date then bid will be opened on next suitable working day.
- 3.1.4.2 The Contractor shall complete within the stipulated time period.
- 3.1.4.3 Bidders shall be asked to supply the items as per specification within the specified delivery/ completion period at designated places within Jaipur and across the State of Rajasthan and the details of supply/ shipping and exact locations where the items need to be supplied shall be specified in the purchase order and/ or contract.
- 3.1.4.4 The Supplier/ Selected Bidder shall arrange to supply the ordered materials as per specifications in bid document.

3.1.5 Recoveries from Supplier/ Contractor

- 3.1.5.1 Recovery of damages, delay, short supply, defects, rejected shall be made ordinarily from bills or Performance Security Deposit (as the case may be).
- 3.1.5.2 The Purchase Officer shall withhold amount to the extent of short supply, broken/ damaged or for rejected material and in case of failure in satisfactory replacement by the supplier along with amount of penalty shall be recovered from his dues and Bid Security available with the department.
- 3.1.5.3 The balance, if any, shall be demanded from the Supplier/ Contractor and when recovery is not possible, the Purchase Officer shall take recourse to law in force.



3.1.6 Specifications and Standards

Technical Specifications and Drawings 3.1.6.1

- The Supplier/ Contractor shall ensure that the goods and related services comply with the technical specifications and other provisions of the Contract.
- The Supplier/ Contractor shall be entitled to disclaim responsibility for any design, data, b. drawing, specification or other document, or any modification thereof provided or designed by or on behalf of the Purchaser, by giving a notice of such disclaimer to the Purchaser.
- The goods and related services supplied under the Contract for execution of work order shall C. conform to the standards mentioned in work order and, when no applicable standard is mentioned, the standard shall be equivalent or superior to the official standards whose application is appropriate to the country of origin of the Goods.
- Wherever references are made in the Contract to codes and standards in accordance with 3.1.6.2 which it shall be executed, the edition or the revised version of such codes and standards shall be those specified in the work order. During Contract execution, any changes in any such codes and standards shall be applied only after approval by the Purchaser and shall be treated in accordance with the general conditions of the contract.

3.1.7 Inspection

The Purchase Officer or his duly authorized representative shall at all reasonable time have 3.1.7.1 access to the supplier's/ Contractor's premises and shall have the power at all reasonable time to inspect and examine the materials and workmanship of the goods/ equipment/ machineries during manufacturing process or afterwards as may be decided.

3.1.8 Rejection

- Articles not approved during inspection or testing shall be rejected and will have to be 3.1.8.1 replaced by the Contractor at his own cost within the time fixed by the Purchase Officer.
- If, however, due to exigencies of work, such replacement either in whole or in part, is not 3.1.8.2 considered feasible, the Purchase Officer after giving an opportunity to the Contractor of being heard shall for reasons to be recorded, deduct a suitable amount from the approved rates. The deduction so made shall be final.
- The rejected articles shall be removed by the supplier/ Bidder/ Contractor within 15 Days of 3.1.8.3 intimation of rejection, after which Purchase Officer shall not be responsible for any loss, shortage or damage and shall have the right to dispose of such articles as he thinks fit, at the Contractor's risk and on his account.

3.1.9 Termination

Termination for Default 3.1.9.1

The bid sanctioning authority of JMRC may, without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of contract, by a written notice of default of at least 30 days sent to the supplier/ Contractor, terminate the contract in whole or in part: -



 If the supplier/ Contractor fails to deliver any or all quantities of the service within the time period specified in the contract, or any extension thereof granted by JMRC;

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 If the supplier/ Contractor fails to perform any other obligation under the contract within the specified period of delivery of service or any extension granted thereof;

Or

- c. If the supplier/ Contractor, in the judgment of the Purchaser, is found to be engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, or coercive practices in competing for or in executing the contract.
- d. If the supplier/ Contractor commits breach of any condition of the contract.
- 3.1.9.2 If JMRC terminates the contract in whole or in part, amount of Performance Security Deposit may be forfeited.
- 3.1.9.3 Before cancelling a contract and taking further action, advice of senior most finance person available in the office and of legal adviser or legal assistant posted in the office, if there is one, may be obtained.

Note: In addition to the conditions specified above, the approved GCC are applicable and available on the JMRC website. The successful bidder shall submit a declaration for acceptance of the terms and conditions mentioned the GCC {clause 6.6 Form F (j) }.

4.0 SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF BID & CONTRACT

4.1 Bidders to Bid for all Items

4.1.1 Bidder must quote for all the items mentioned in the BOQ (Bill of Quantities). In case, a Bidder does not quote for any item, the bid shall be summarily rejected.

4.2 Payment Terms and Schedule and Penalty:

4.2.1.1 Payment Terms:

- 4.2.1.1.1 No advance payment will be done.
- 4.2.1.1.2 The payment will be made on satisfactory completion of individual work as per specified against each LOI (Letter of Indent). The contractor should submit Tax Invoice/bill of each work against each LOI (Letter of Indent).
- 4.2.1.1.3 Payment to the Bidder shall be made as per accepted rates on actual work done against each LOI after submission of bill along with the service reports duly verified from the JMRC in charge and Test Certificates, as per BOQ.
- 4.2.1.1.4 Due payments shall be made promptly by the purchaser, at earliest after submission of an invoice or request for payment by the supplier/ Bidder, and the purchaser has accepted it.
- 4.2.1.1.5 The currency or currencies in which payments shall be made to the supplier/ Bidder under this Contract shall be Indian Rupees (INR) only.
- 4.2.1.1.6 All remittance charges will be borne by the supplier/ Bidder.
- 4.2.1.1.7 Payment in case of those goods which need testing shall be made only when such tests have been carried out, test results received conforming to the prescribed specification.



4.2.1.2 Penalty Terms:

- 4.2.1.8.1 If the contractor fails to respond/commence the work at site within 2 days of issue of each LOI (Letter of Indent) then a penalty of 0.5% per day of total value of amount of that particular LOI (Letter of Indent) shall be imposed. This penalty amount shall be deducted from the running bill of contractor.
- 4.2.1.8.2 If the contractor fails to complete the work at site within the time mentioned in each LOI (Letter of Indent) then a penalty of 0.25% per day of total value of amount of that particular LOI (Letter of Indent) shall be imposed. This penalty amount shall be deducted from the running bill of contractor.
- 4.2.1.8.3 Repeated failure or frequent complaints shall be treated as unsatisfactory performance on part of contractor and JMRC shall have the sole right to terminate this contract on account of unsatisfactory performance which shall be determinable at the sole discretion of the employer. Such termination shall be affected by serving a notice by the employer to the authorized representative of the contractor in this regard with forfeiting performance security and resorting to other consequences.
- 4.2.1.8.4 The total penalty amount shall not exceed 10% of Total contract amount.
- 4.2.1.8.5 Delivery period may be extended with or without penalty if the delay in the supply of goods and related services/work is on account of hindrances beyond the control of the Bidder by taking pre-approval from the competent authority.

4.3 Warranty

- 4.3.1.1 Warranty term should be clearly indicated in the offer.
- 4.3.1.2 Warranty term should be clearly indicated in the offer. Minimum warranty period is required 12 months from the date of successful completion of each specified work as per BOQ and LOI issued. So, in this period if any spare/service found not satisfactory working then Action will be taken according (Recoveries from Supplier/ Bidder Para 3.1.5).

If any Bidder or prospective bidder is aggrieved that any decision, action or omission of the Procuring Entity is in contravention to the provisions of the Act or the Rules or the Guidelines issued there under, he may file an appeal to First Appellate Authority, as specified in the Bidding Document within a period of ten days from the date of such decision or action, omission, as the case may be, clearly giving the specific ground or grounds on which he feels aggrieved:

Provided that after the declaration of a Bidder as successful the appeal may be filed only by a Bidder who has participated in procurement proceedings:
